Topic 1: Hong Kong List Learning Test (Chan, 2006)

Date: 6 & 7 May, 2010 (Thursday & Friday)

(Day 1) Theory and basic concepts, administration & scoring

(Day 2) Basic profile interpretation of various memory disorders

Details: The Hong Kong List Learning Test (HKLLT) 2nd Edition is a Chinese list-learning test assessing the processes and organizational strategies involved in learning verbal information. Normative data from age 6 through 95 years, and data of brain-damaged patients with different etiologies were collected in past decade. The basic theory, test administration, and unique profiles of patients with different neurological and psychiatric problems will be discussed in the workshop.

Topic 2: Chinese Mattis Dementia Rating Scale (Chan, Poon, Choi, Cheung, 2001)

Date: 13 May, 2010 (Thursday)

Basic concepts, clinical application and profile interpretation

Details: The Chinese Mattis Dementia Rating Scale (CDRS) is the official Chinese version published with the permission of the Psychological Assessment Resources (PAR), Inc. It is a culturally adapted screening instrument to detect and track the progression of dementia for Chinese. The workshop will cover the basic theoretical concepts of dementia, the clinical validity and applicability of the CDRS, and profiles of patients with various degree of severity of dementia.

Professor Agnes Chan is a Clinical Neuropsychologist. She is currently a Professor in the Department of Psychology at the Chinese University of Hong Kong and the Director of the Integrative Neuropsychological Rehabilitation Center. She is the author of the Hong Kong List Learning Test and the Chinese Mattis Dementia Rating Scale. These tests are two of the most commonly used clinical neuropsychological tests in Hong Kong. Prof. Chan is an active researcher with her research projects published in top-ranking international journals including Nature, Neuropsychology, Archive of Neurology and Cancer. She has also served on the editorial boards of the Neuropsychology and the Journal of the International Neuropsychological Society. Furthermore, Prof. Chan has been awarded the Early Career Award by the American Psychological Association in 2004.
